HAGGERSTON ESTATE - HACKNEY EAST LONDON

PROJECT WIN - BRIGHTON

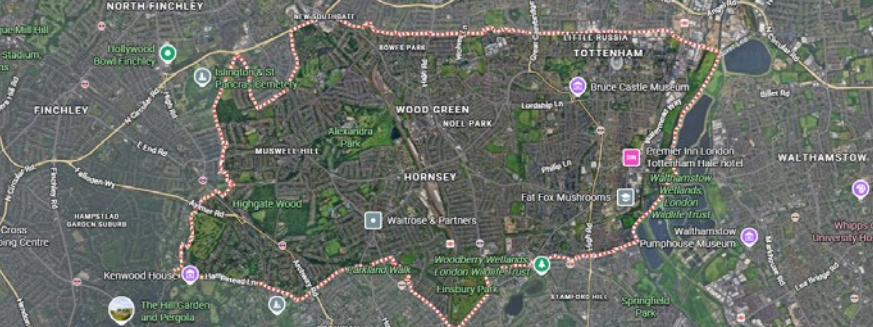


Embassy Scaffolding Division have successfully negotiated the scaffold and access package on this regeneration project in Brighton.
